What is the Forum? The Forum is a members' only resource that facilitates knowledge and document sharing between members of APA-IN. All content and materials are contributed by members and posted in a searchable online forum available 24/7.

How do I subscribe? You can subscribe to the Forum, or to individual topics within the Forum. You are able to set the method of notification (daily, weekly, or immediate) for when a topic is created or a response to a topic has occurred. By default, email notifications of Forum updates are sent on a daily basis, however you can change that setting once you have subscribed.

How can I contribute? Post content, ask and answer questions, and share documents. The more you participate, the more valuable this resource will become for the entire APA-IN membership.

Members are encouraged to contribute any non-copyrighted document that may be of use or interest to other members. Of particular interest are materials that are routinely or periodically used and will save other members the trouble of "re-inventing the wheel" as well as materials and sample documents that can be used for training purposes.
